Local Offroad Racing Team returns home after a 3rd place finish in the 42nd running of the BAJA 1000. With every turn of this 1062km adventure, they raised money for The Vancouver Firefighters Charitable Society and Firefighters Without Borders.

On Saturday, November 21st, 2009, YOLO Racing crossed the finish line with a time of 27hrs, 52min. This placed them 3rd in class and 162nd out of the 328 competitors that started the race. Only 185 competitors finished this year's legendary BAJA 1000, a race that attracts race teams from around the world. Held annually on the treacherous and unforgiving Baja California of Mexico, this world famous desert race has 27 classes with entries from 30 States and over a dozen countries. The grueling course runs through villages along the peninsula luring over 200,000 spectators. Each team follows the same rule, "In order to finish first, you must first finish. Never, ever give up". The YOLO Racing team battled through sand dunes, rugged mountain passes, river washes, rollovers and a host of other set backs to complete the race within the 31hr time limit.
