Canadian off road racing team returns home to Vancouver B.C. with a first place finish in the 26th MasterCraft Safety Tecate SCORE San Felipe BAJA 250. Winning their class makes them the first Canadian team in the 26 year history of this legendary race to do so.

On March 10th, 2012, YOLO Racing along with 250 adventure seekers challenged each other and the insane Baja terrain. Navigating through silt, jagged rocks, extreme heat, sand sections, canyons and with narrow canyon passes. This 250 mile course is considered to be the hardest 250 miles that any desert race has to offer. Finshing with a time of 9hrs 09min of continuous racing the driver and copilot were tested on many levels. The team is now preparing for the next race in the series, the 26th running of the SCORE BAJA 500, June 1st 2012. This 500 mile race will start and finish in Ensenada, a seaside town on the beautiful and rugged Baja Peninsula of Mexico.

With every twist and turn of this adventure the team is in support of Firefighters Without Borders Canada. By way of a driveathon the team raises funds for variuos projects focusing the resources on various communities on the Baja of Mexico.
